UC Scholarship Overview

FIGR's UC Scholarship provides in-state systemwide Tuition and Student Services Fees and Campus Fees for students who are California Native Americans but not members of a federally recognized tribe. This scholarship applies to undergraduate and graduate students for professional and non-professional degrees.

- If you are a member of a Federally Recognized Tribe, please visit the UC's Native American Opportunity Plan (NAOP) at UC Admissions (admission.universityofcalifornia.edu).

Documentation Required:

- 1. Completed Application
- 2.A copy of the applicant's state-issued photo identification card or driver's license
- 3. One of the following:
 - CDIB showing a California tribal affiliation; or
 - Original or Certified copies of original birth or death certificates for each generation of the applicants' ancestry linking them back to a person with a CDIB showing a California tribal affiliation, on the California census rolls of 1928 or 1933, or on the California Judgment Fund Rolls of 1953 or 1972; and
- 4. Completed family tree form, if appropriate.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the FIGR UC Scholarship, applicants must meet <u>ALL</u> of the following criteria:

- 1. Not a member of a Federally Recognized tribe;
- 2. Either:
 - Have a certificate of Degree of Indian Blood (CDIB) showing a California tribal affiliation; or
 - Descend from a person with a Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood (CDIB) showing a California tribal affiliation, on the California census rolls of 1928 or 1933, or on the California Judgment Fund Rolls of 1953 or 1972;
- 3. California Resident;
- 4. Current or newly admitted UC undergraduate, graduate, or professional school student; and
- 5. Enrolled in a Qualifying UC Degree Program.

How to Apply

- 1. Complete the FIGR UC Scholarship application.
- 2. Mail or FedEx the Completed Application and supporting documents. We are not accepting emails or faxes at this time.
